
AFGHANISTAN - Central Highlands Zone - Bamyan Province - Bamyan District Shelter types arrangement pattern - Rural area - June 2021

Shelter Type	Description
Black Tent	Collapsible tents made of woven goat hair panels, sometimes supported by woven reed mat walls. They are commonly used among nomadic peoples (kuchi).
Cotton Tent	Canvas tents are pre-manufactured or made by stitching pieces of cloth together and supported with poles.
Hut	Mobile shelters made of woven reed or tamarisk mats held by poles.
Curved Roof	Permanent shelters made of packed mud or bricks. The roof of the shelter is made of brick and is shaped like a dome or arch.
Flat Roof	Permanent shelter with mud, brick, or stone walls, and wood -supported flat roofs. These shelters are constructed with stone timber, bricks, pakhsa, or a combination thereof.
Cave	Permanent shelter made from a natural void in the side of a hill, mountain, or cliff-face.
